### NOTE TO PARENTS:

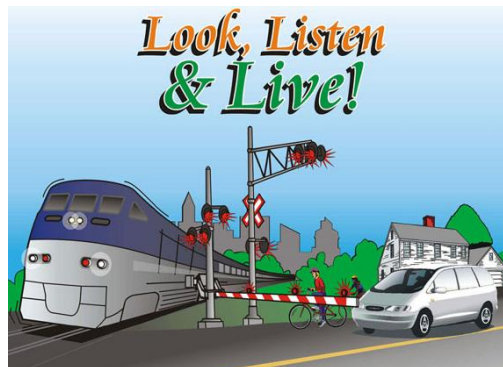
This Award will give you the opportunities to take part in activities with your children. It is in fact an Award for the entire family, and your involvement is vital to the program's success.

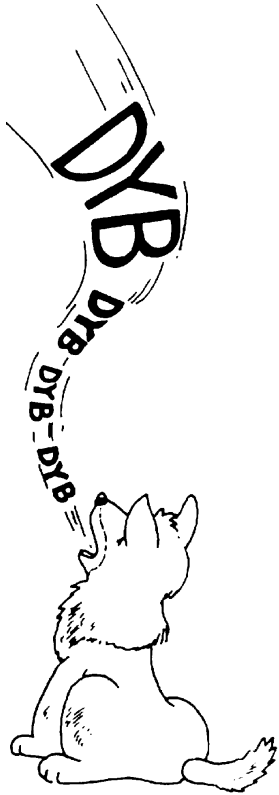
